Keynote Speaker Profile



Tim Shannon, M.D.

General Partner, Canaan Partners

Tim Shannon, M.D., has been an entrepreneur, researcher, professor, and a practicing physician in pulmonary and critical care medicine. Since 2009, Tim has been a partner at Canaan Partners. Canaan Partners manages over \$4.2 billion in healthcare and technology venture funds. Most recently, Tim was startup CEO of two Canaan portfolio companies, ALDEA and Arvinas. He serves on the boards of Aldea Pharmaceuticals, Arvinas, CytomX Therapeutics, Novira Therapeutics, Vivace Therapeutics, and Spyryx Biosciences, while serving as the Chairman of both

Arvinas and Spyryx. Through 2014, Tim served as a director at Celldex Therapeutics, which acquired CuraGen in October 2009. Prior to Canaan Partners, Tim was president and CEO of CuraGen, a biopharmaceutical company focused on oncology, after serving as executive vice president of R&D and as chief medical officer. He also held positions of increasing responsibility for Bayer's Pharmaceutical Business Group including senior vice president of global medical development. Prior to his biopharmaceutical career, Tim was assistant professor of the pulmonary and critical care division at Yale University School of Medicine and an attending physician in pulmonary and critical care medicine at the West Haven V.A. Medical Center. Tim received his post graduate medical training at the Beth Israel Hospital of Harvard Medical School and at Boston University. He earned his medical degree from the University of Connecticut, and has a B.A. in chemistry from Amherst College.
