

## 2019 Frontiers in Undergraduate Research Poster Exhibition

Instructions for Students Presenting at **SESSION #4: Saturday, April 13 - 12:00-1:30 p.m.**

Thank you for your participation in the 22nd Annual Frontiers in Undergraduate Research Poster Exhibition. **The following information will help you prepare for this event. Please read carefully.** Your presentation date and time is as follows:

**Session #4 – Saturday, April 13, 2019 from 12:00 p.m. to 1:30 p.m.**

Location: North Reading Room, Wilbur Cross Building

Note: We invite you to attend the Frontiers reception, which will take place in the North Reading Room and hallway from 5:30 - 6:30 p.m. on Friday evening (April 12).

**Check-In:** All presenters **MUST** check in at the Wilbur Cross Rotunda (the “Ant” room) **no later than 11:40am**. At the time of check-in, all student presenters will receive a name tag, presentation instructions, a board funding sign (if applicable), and a brief student survey.

**Poster Display:** All presentations will be set up poster-style in the Wilbur Cross Building's North Reading Room. You will be able to set up your poster display beginning at 11:40 a.m. on Saturday, April 13<sup>th</sup>. **All posters must be set up and ready by 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 13<sup>th</sup>.**

For advice on poster design, consult [ugradresearch.uconn.edu/poster-presentations/](http://ugradresearch.uconn.edu/poster-presentations/) and consult your advisor(s); many faculty members will be familiar with poster formats used for national conferences in your discipline. Poster space is a 46 in. (vertical) by 70 in. (horizontal) display. There is approximately 24 in. of space below the poster stand if extra space is needed. The poster boards will be covered with navy blue paper as a background for your display. We will provide pins for you to mount your poster. A chair will be placed at each poster board.

**Responsibilities:** As a Frontiers participant, you are responsible for a professional display of your project question/topic, methods, and findings to date.

- **You must take down all of your presentation materials (including the blue background paper) and clean the area around your display after the conclusion of Session 4 at 1:30 p.m.**

**Dress Code:** As a Frontiers participant, you will be representing the University of Connecticut at one of the largest showcase events on campus. You are expected to respect that privilege and dress in professional attire for your presentation. Acceptable attire includes: shirt and tie for men (jacket not required), skirt or dress slacks for women. *Do not wear sneakers or flip flops.*

**Friday Reception:** A reception with remarks will be held in your honor on Friday, April 12, 2019 from 5:30 – 6:30 p.m. in the hallway outside the Wilbur Cross North Reading Room. Hot and cold hors d'oeuvres will be served. Please invite your advisor to join us for the reception. **The recipients of the 2019 Mentorship Excellence Awards will be announced at the reception as well.**

**Volunteers:** Volunteers are needed to help with room set up on Friday, April 12<sup>th</sup> (8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.) and clean up following the poster presentation on Saturday, April 13<sup>th</sup> (1:30 p.m. – 3:00 p.m.).
